











<p>5-6mm Lesser Housefly</p>  <p><i>Fannia scalaris</i></p> <p>Features Grey thorax with three indistinct longitudinal stripes. Abdomen has extensive area of yellow at base.</p> <p>Control PestWest sticky traps and fly killers are effective at controlling the lesser housefly.</p>	<p>7-15mm Mosquitoes</p>  <p><i>Culex spp.</i></p> <p>Features Slender, long-legged insect with forward-pointing, piercing and sucking mouthparts. Wingspan 7-15mm.</p> <p>Control PestWest units are extremely effective at catching mosquitoes.</p>
<p>9-13mm Blowfly</p>  <p><i>Calliphora spp.</i></p> <p>Features Thorax and abdomen black/blue in colour and often with a metallic appearance. Wingspan 18-20mm.</p> <p>Control All PestWest fly killers are a very effective step in controlling these pests.</p>	<p>15-20mm Wasp</p>  <p><i>Vespa spp.</i></p> <p>Features Black head and thorax, black and yellow patterning on abdomen.</p> <p>Control PestWest sticky traps and electronic fly killers are particularly effective at attracting and controlling wasps.</p>
<p>10mm Cluster Fly</p>  <p><i>Pollenia rudis</i></p> <p>Features Large flies, wingspan up to 20mm. Thorax distinctive dark grey/olive colour covered in golden hairs.</p> <p>Control Areas where flies congregate should be treated with residual insecticide. PestWest fly killers are a very effective step in controlling cluster flies.</p>	<p>3-4mm Scuttle Fly/Phorid Fly</p>  <p><i>Megaselia spp.</i></p> <p>Features Thorax dark brown/tan with distinctive humped appearance.</p> <p>Control Chameleon[®] sticky traps and electronic fly killers are extremely effective at attracting and controlling these pests.</p>
<p>5-6mm Mushroom/Fungus Fly</p>  <p><i>Solaria thomae</i></p> <p>Features Small insects, wingspan 14-15mm. Black head, thorax and abdomen. Thorax has humped appearance.</p> <p>Control Chameleon[®] sticky traps are a very effective step in controlling mushroom flies.</p>	<p>1.2-1.5mm Biting Midge</p>  <p><i>Culiseta spp.</i></p> <p>Features Dark brown/black in colour. Wingspan 3-4mm. Will swarm in large numbers and inflict bites.</p> <p>Control Insect repellents should be used when outdoors to prevent bites. Chameleon[®] sticky traps will attract and control midges.</p>
<p>3mm Fruit Fly</p>  <p><i>Drosophila spp.</i></p> <p>Features Small yellowish brown with darkly striped abdomen. Prominent red eyes.</p> <p>Control Chameleon[®] sticky traps are extremely effective at controlling these smaller insects.</p>	<p>6-8mm Common Housefly</p>  <p><i>Musca domestica</i></p> <p>Features Thorax grey with four longitudinal dark stripes. Sides of abdomen are yellowish and may be transparent. A dark band covers the final abdomen segments.</p> <p>Control PestWest fly killers and sticky traps will effectively control houseflies.</p>
